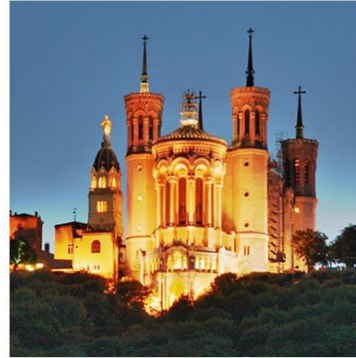

# Travel



## By plane:

The main airport to reach Lyon is the Lyon Saint Exupery international airport, located at 25 km East of Lyon and with **regular direct flights to more than 40 countries**.

From Lyon Saint Exupery airport, the city center can be reached very easily by taking the express train Rhonexpress to the central Lyon Part-Dieu train station. There are trains every 15 minutes and the journey takes **30 minutes**.

## By train:

Lyon is very well connected to major cities in Europe by train, and can be reached both by **normal trains** (TER) and by **TGV** (high speed trains).

In particular, there are regular trains (about 30 per day) from Paris city center and Paris Charles de Gaulle airport, and the trip takes about 2 hours.

Lyon is also connected to Spain via Barcelona and to the East via Geneva.
